Dear Missioner, Marinduqueno Family and Friends:

The Marinduque International Inc. (MI, Inc) is extending an invitation to you to join a team of doctors, nurses, and volunteers who are going to the Philippines to hold its Mission of Love VII on February 4 to 13, 2011.

Since 1996, MI, Inc. has undertaken six medical missions participated by its nine chapters in the U.S., Canada and Saudi Arabia. On the previous medical mission held on February 2008, approximately 120 medical practitioners performed medical treatments to over 6,500 patients and 50 surgical operations were carried out at the provincial hospital.

On December 1, 2006, the island of Marinduque was hit by typhoon *Reming*. It swept through the island, devastated over 90% of the province's structures, and ruined its agriculture and vegetation. This calamity further set back the economic lives of the people so that very little was left for anything else especially their health care needs.

Our historical data clearly showed a steady increase in the number of people needing medical help. In our February 2011 Medical Mission, we are anticipating that more than 8,000 impoverished townfolk will take advantage of our medical services and medicines. Please help us serve these people.
